Welcome to the Tikkun Olam End of Financial Year 2022 – 2023 report.

Despite some fairly grim signs in the world today that the 21st Century does not appear to be heading in a positive direction, your ministry to the Jewish people has continued to help alleviate suffering and bring some much-needed joy into the lives of local Jewish people.

The Ukraine-Russia war, supply chain shortages, power price increases, inflation and mortgage rate hikes are some of the negative issues that are affecting everyday people.

Tikkun Olam has distributed hundreds of food hampers and vouchers over the past year to needy Jewish individuals and families around Australia. You will read in this report how your generosity has brought great blessings to those who need a hand-up and some joy in their lives.

During the year, we established a new arm of the ministry to host Tikkun Olam recipients for a monthly lunch at the Caulfield Messianic Centre. This has proved to be a wonderful time of deeper connections with people, including those we have been ministering to for years. It has given our volunteers the opportunity to forge closer relationships with those they've been visiting to drop off hampers.

Throughout the past year we have packed and delivered a total of 715 food hampers, provided 161 food vouchers and 4 monthly lunches. The total costs including all expenses was \$120,000.00 The table below breaks this down for each region in which we operate:

A New Initiative for Tikkun Olam

Beginning in March 2023, we have expanded Tikkun Olam's activities with monthly luncheons at our Caulfield Messianic Centre in Melbourne. Invitations are sent to members of the community that we know are in need. At the luncheon, the recipients enjoy a catered lunch alongside our staff members and volunteers. Our attendees greatly appreciate the communal atmosphere, warm conversation and special food.



The group includes single mothers, single fathers, the elderly, and young families, all in need in some way. Each has stories to tell of the challenges life has thrown at them. We have had approximately 20 to 30 people each month.

We have found these luncheons to be an open door to share the gospel. Our April luncheon was only a week after Passover, and the attendees were interested in how we celebrate Passover as Messianic believers. As a result, we had the opportunity to share the Messianic significance of Yeshua in the Passover. Additionally, attendees are able to view the sanctuary,





the Torah in the ark, and the replica Western Wall in the dining area of the Messianic Centre. Thus, even our building has been a testament to our belief in Yeshua as the promised Messiah while still celebrating our Jewish heritage.

We strive for excellence because nothing less will do as we work to be the hands and feet of our Messiah Yeshua on this earth. This has enabled us to get to know and understand those in our community and their specific needs.
